## Identification of coma

Clinical evidence of cause of coma with likely mechanism leading to death by

neurological criteria (DNC)
(possibly supported by history, neuroimaging, cerebrospinal fluid, etc.)

## **Exclusion of**

- Hypothermia
- Intoxication
- Sedative drugs
- Neuromuscular blocking agents
- Severe electrolyte, acid-base or endocrine abnormality



Absent brain stem reflexes Absent motor responses

Apnoea with clear rise in  $PaCO_2$  levels of >2.7 kPa (>20 mm Hg) above a baseline of at least 5.3 kPa (40 mm Hg) to >8.0 kPa (60 mm Hg)
